- **SCRAMBLE**

- 2 or 4 Person

- All team members hit from the teeing ground and select the best ball. After selecting your best shot, ALL players will play from that spot within one club length, but no closer to the hole. This process continues until the ball is holed out.

- **MODIFIED SCRAMBLE**

- 2 or 4 Person

- All team members hit from the teeing ground and select the best ball. Each player plays their OWN BALL from that point until their ball is holed. Team scores may be counted by using the 1, 2, or 3 net best balls.

- **FLORIDA SCRAMBLE**

- 4 Person

- All team members hit from the teeing ground and select the best ball. After selecting your best shot, **the person whose ball was selected sits out the next shot**, the remaining players will play from that spot within one club length, but no closer to the hole. This process continues until the ball is holed out.

- **ALTERNATE SHOT**

- 2 or 4 Person

- The basics of an alternate shot format is two or four golfers playing the same ball. One player drives the ball, another hits the second shot. The players continue to alternate until the ball is in the hole. OPTION – Women tee off ODD numbered holes / Men tee off EVEN numbered holes.
 - There are three main variations of the alternate shot game:
 - **Scotch Doubles:** Golfers decide in advance who will drive the even holes and who will drive the odd holes (Thus, each player tees off on nine holes). Players alternate shots until the ball is in the hole.
 - **Pinehurst:** Both golfers tee off on every hole. Then, each team decides which ball to use. Players then alternate shots until the hole is finished.
 - **Chapman:** Similar to Pinehurst, with both golfers teeing off on every hole. Players then alternate and hit their partners' shots. Then, each team decides which ball to use, and players then alternate shots until the hole is finished.

- **DOT GAME**
 - 2 or 4 Person
 - Play regular golf. Team score may be based on the 1, 2, 3, or 4 Net Best Balls of the team which is predetermined prior to the round.

- **LOW NET (Regular Golf)**
 - 2 or 4 Person
 - Play regular golf. Team score is based on the team total less total of team handicap.

- **NET BEST BALL MIXED**
 - 4 Person
 - Play regular golf. Team score is based on 1 net best ball from holes 1-9, 2 net best balls from holes 10 – 17, and 3 net best balls from hole 18.

- **HIGH / LOW**
 - 4 Person
 - Play regular golf. Team score is based on the low net ball and high net ball on each hole.

- **WALTZ GAME**
 - 4 Person
 - Play regular golf. Team score is based on 1 net best ball on hole1, 2 net best balls on hole 2, 3 net best balls on hole 3, 1 net best ball on hole 4, etc.
 - Holes 1-4-7 1 Low Net
 - Holes 2-5-8 2 Low Nets
 - Holes 3-6-9 3 Low Nets

- **BEST 9 DOUBLED**
 - 2 Person
 - Play regular golf. Double the best nine and subtract your handicap.

- **3 WORST HOLES OR 1 WORST HOLE**
 - 2 or 4 Person
 - Play regular golf. Select three worst holes and deduct from total 18 hole score. Can also be played by selecting one worst hole and deducting from the total 18 hole score.
